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ARESTIN

ARESTIN, an antimicrobial gel, has been administered as part of your periodontal therapy. Please follow these guidelines to insure the maximum benefits of this treatment.

After treatment, avoid eating hard, crunchy or sticky foods for one week.

Postpone brushing for twelve hours following administration of Arestin, and avoid touching treated areas.

Avoid the use of interproximal cleaning devices (“Christmas-tree brushes”), as well as flossing, for 10 days following treatment.

Although some mild to moderate sensitivity is expected during the first week following treatment, please notify our office promptly if pain, swelling, or other problems occur.

ARESTIN should not be used in any patient who has a known sensitivity to minocycline or tetracyclines.
